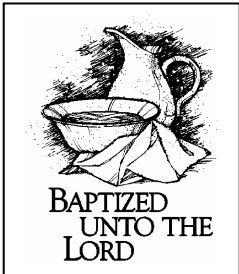

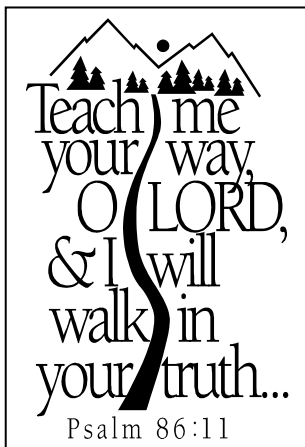

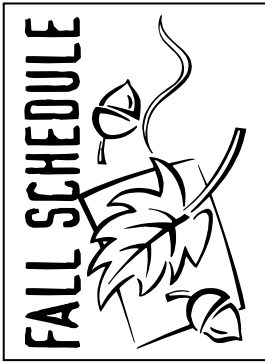


**DEACON'S 5<sup>th</sup> SUNDAY OFFERING**

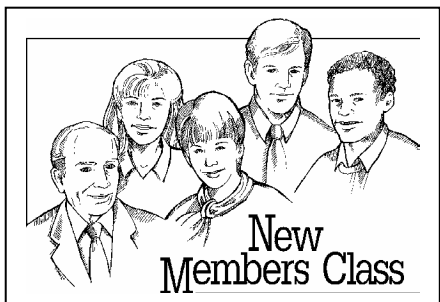

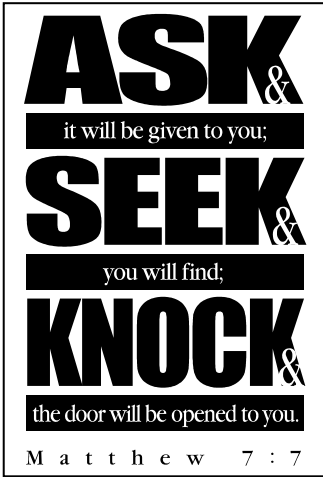
